

# **FOUR-YEAR PLAN**

- Supporting national club competitions
- Tailored programme for each category underdeveloped, emerging and developed - to promote and improve handball in these areas.
- The Four-Year Plan started in 2014 in Europe and extended to Pan America in 2016. It was introduced in Africa in 2017 and will be launched in Asia in 2019.
- Next Step
  Is to Implement the project in the rest of the continents.









The IHF is working in close cooperation with the

top nations to increase the number of NFs participating in this discipline to be able to organise World Championships in order to meet the conditions stipulated by the International Paralympic Committee.

In 2018, the IHF Wheelchair Handball Working Group was created.

- The Working Group is currently working on new wheelchair handball rules.
- National Federations and Continental Confederations practising wheelchair handball need to be contacted in order to organise the continental qualifications for a World Championship.

# **EDUCATION COURSES**


Education is the main tool of success, many courses in different fields were organised within several projects. The IHF plans to continue the organisation of the education courses on all levels and for different fields.

# COURSES FOR NATIONAL TEAM COACHES

The IHF successfully organised educational courses in three continents (Africa, Pan America and Asia) in 2015, 2016, 2018 and 2019.

The IHF plans to continue the organisation of these important courses which foster the quality of the national team coaches, especially in the emerging nations.



### GLOBAL COACHING CLINIC

The GCC is ranked Licence A in the new IHF Coaching Education structure.

The GCC curriculum is being in the process of formalisation by the IHF top experts.

The Licence A stipulated criteria guarantee that only the top coaches who meet these criteria will be part of the course and granted the A certificate.





# TRAVELLER COACH



The project was launched in 2014 and served so far:

The successful implementation of the project encouraged the IHF to continue in the future.



### COUNTRIES THAT BID FOR OR HOSTED OG

- The New Markets' Project has already been launched. Great Britain, PR of China and the United States of America have already been integrated into the project.
- Japan is joining the project. The IHF is working jointly with the National Association of Japan and the NOC to promote handball and develop the standard of Japan's national teams over the next three years.
- All countries which hosted or will host the Olympic Games will be integrated automatically into the project to help develop our sport and maintain the legacy.

The IHF is in contact with several brands trying to bring them aboard.



   Group








### **RESIN-FREE HANDBALL**

- Due to past experience, the IHF plans to eliminate the use of resin in handball matches.
- The IHF launched the resin free ball project in 2013 when the IHF signed the contract with Molten.
- Molten company is committed to develop the resin-free ball and spent already over a million USD in developing and testing stages.
- Molten produced several prototypes which were all very successful; each was developed to avoid that the ball temporarily loses its adhesiveness when it comes into contact with sweat.
- Molten will officially present the new ball at the 2019 IHF Congress.
- After several tests, the new ball shall be presented at the 2020 IHF Women's Youth World Championship.

## **GOOD GOVERNANCE**

The IHF is working in close cooperation with our Continental Confederations, legal commissions and Member Federations to solve any disputes or irregularities in implementing the IHF Statutes and Regulations and to preserve the autonomy of our Member Federations.

The IHF is keen to have good governance principles at all its stakeholders levels: Clubs, NFs, Continental Confederations as well as the governing body 'the IHF'.



# HANDBALL

- The IHF organised two successful editions of the IHF Forum for the Future of Handball.
- Constantly looking to improve the image and popularity of handball, the IHF is preserving the organisation of this important gathering and brainstorming event where all the handball experts from different fields - marketing, TV, coaches, players, referees and administration are coming together to study and elaborate the best future of handball.





# **PLAYERS' COMPENSATION**

- The IHF started in 2011 paying Players' compensation for senior World Championships (men) and in 2013 (women);
- The compensation includes:
- Qualification bonus for qualified NFs
- Daily allowance for the players taking part in the Championship
- Loss of salary insurance
- Prize money
- The IHF shall keep up paying the compensation for the senior World Championships which is considered a big support for the NFs and the clubs.

### INTERNATIONAL HANDBALL DAY

# **GENDER EQUALITY**

- The Athletes' Commission is presided by a woman for the first time.
- The IHF Women's Handball Working Group consists only of women, presided by former international player from Romania.
- IHF organised the 2<sup>nd</sup> IHF Women's Forum in 2015 in Qatar.
- Two former women's players are part of the IHF Executive Committee.
