

Pan-American Team Handball Federation (PATHF)

PATHF appeal to IHF Arbitration Commission dated 14 December 2017 against **IHF Congress decision** dated 11 November 2017 related to Pan-American motion (authorising the IHF Council to discuss, evaluate and take a decision on the motion regarding the IHF Statutes related to the Pan-American continent and consequently on the relevant IHF Statutes changes)

IHF Arbitration Commission decision dated 14 February 2018:

The appeal filed by Pan-American Team Handball Federation ("PATHF"), represented by its president Mr Mario Moccia, on 14 December 2017 is rejected.
