LEARNING STEP-BY-STEP

PHILOSOPHY

In 2011, the International Handball Federation (IHF) launched Handball at School (H@S), a worldwide training and education programme for PE teachers.

Under the motto **"Fun, Passion and Health,"** we set out to revolutionize the teaching of handball in schools, creating a universal programme that would increase participation in and awareness of our great sport.

The underlying philosophical principles of this H@S programme include:

- Learning step-by-step
- Respect to child developmental stages
- **Develop** positive experience in physical education
 - Pursuant to health and fitness standards
 - According to fair play, team spirit, friendship, healthy lifestyle
- Gain personal experience of success, failure, cooperation, responsibility, confidence, etc. through playing Handball at school
- **Emphasis on** enjoyment, motivation, participation, integration, inclusion, equality, intelligence, communication, etc

REMARKS

H@S programme can greatly contribute to the **physical**, **social and intellectual development** of youngsters as well as promote **Physical Literacy for Communities**.

HANDBALL AT SCHOOL

The **Handball at School programme** has the potential to develop and broaden the foundation of "learning by **doing"** that takes place in physical education. In the first nine years of the programme, we have carried out more than 100 interventions around the world, and with the support of the hosting federations, we have identified and developed three key epicenters in each country.

The **first step** in all interventions is recognising the national body in charge of implementing school sport activities for school-aged children.

These bodies are different from one country to another, and range from ministries of education to ministries of sport to National Olympic Committees.

No matter the administrative organisation or structure of a country, **our main goals always remains the same:**

- to introduce H@S programme to decision-makers
- to make handball an elemental part of PE curriculum

WE DISTINGUISH FOUR MAIN CATEGORIES IN TEACHING PROCESS:

The H@S programme develops across the first three categories, where the primary factor is the level and the secondary factor is the age of the children.

BEGINNER (5-11 years)
