

In accordance with Article 14.3 of the International Handball Federation ("IHF ADR"), the IHF hereby reports that the Player Ms Camille Ems LOFTUS (AUS) has committed an Anti-Doping Rule Violation under Article 2.1 of the IHF ADR – Presence of a Prohibited Substance or its Metabolites or Markers in a Player's Sample.

More precisely, a sample collected from the Player on 1 August 2019 during the IHF Women's Super Globe has revealed the Presence of the prohibited substance phentermine listed under S.6 Stimulants of the 2019 and 2020 WADA Prohibited Lists.

The Player has been sanctioned as follows:

1. Ms Camille Ems LOFTUS has committed a violation of Article 2.1 of the IHF ADR;
2. Ms Camille Ems LOFTUS is suspended for a period of *Ineligibility* of **4 years**;
3. In application of Article 11.3 of the IHF ADR, the period of *Ineligibility* starts on 18 September 2019, and shall remain in full force and effect until 17 September 2023;
4. In accordance with Articles 9 and 11.1 of the IHF ADR, all the results achieved by the Player at the IHF Women's Super Globe are disqualified with all resulting consequences. Additionally, in accordance with Article 11.8 of the IHF ADR, all the competitive results of the Player from 1 August 2019 until 18 September 2019 are disqualified with all the resulting consequences.
