EDUCATION

From 2009 to 2014 Roman Lebedenko studied in the Institute of Justice of the Saratov State Law Academy and received a specialist's degree in Justice.

In 2011 Roman participated in the "Protection of Human Rights in International Relations" course in the St. Petersburg Prince of Oldenburg Institute.

In 2013 he took part in the "Legal Protection of Nature" course in the Ural State Law Academy.

In 2017 Roman studied sports law in the Regulation and legal aspects of sport executive education program in the Moscow State University of International Relations and graduated with distinction.

PROFESSIONAL EXPERIENCE

From 2011 to 2012 Roman Lebedenko worked in the LLC VVT Trade company as a lawyer.

From 2012 to 2014 Roman provided legal assistance pro bono as a lawyer in the Saratov State Law Academy.

From 2014 to 2016 he was the Head of the Claims Department in the LLC Glavdostavka.

Since 2015 Roman works in the Handball Federation of Russia.

SPORT MANAGEMENT EXPERIENCE

Roman Lebedenko is directly involved in the process of formation of internal HFR regulations, such as Statutes, competition regulations, marketing regulations, Code of Ethics, etc. He makes analysis of the documentation and checks its compliance with the law.

Roman regularly participates in the meetings of the HFR Commission for Arbitration for Sport. The main purpose of this commission is to review and decide on disciplinary cases which occur in Russian handball. Since 2015 he also participates in the meetings of the HFR EXEC.

Since 2015 Roman Lebedenko is the Member of the HFR Commission for the admission of clubs to competitions. This Commission takes place every August before the start of a new season, and its members check carefully whether all the documents provided by the clubs follow the criteria set by the Federation.

Roman regularly provides legal assistance to the Russian clubs and Federation's employees.

On December 21, 2017 Roman Lebedenko took part in the meeting of the EHF Court of Handball dedicated to the case of Antonina Skorobogatchenko, Mariia Duvakina and Mariia Dudina.

In December 2019 he participated in the Russian national Master coach courses and delivered a lecture about the current state of affairs in the sports law field.
