To administer and manage the Classification process, International Handball Federation (IHF), (**we, us, or our**) must collect and Process Personal Information about Athletes and any Athlete Support Persons, National Federation representatives, and/or interpreters (collectively **your**). IHF is the controller of your Personal Information in this context, and this Classification Privacy Notice (**Notice**) explains the types of Personal Information we collect about you, the purposes for which we Process it, the parties with whom we share it, rights you may have in relation to your Personal Information, and other relevant information.

I. Types of Personal Information we collect and Process

As part of the Classification process, we may Process a range of Personal Information about Athletes, Athlete Support Persons, National Federation representatives, and interpreters, which we may collect from you directly or receive from other sources such as your National Federation. This includes, as applicable:

- **Name(s) and contact information**, such as first name(s), family name(s), previous name(s), alias, email address, phone number, mailing address, and any other contact information you provide;
- **Demographic information**, such as date of birth, (sport) gender, nationality, country/National Federation represented, and professional details (e.g., role/title, translation capabilities, and so forth);
- **Sport-related information**, such as the sport(s) an Athlete is competing in, Sport Class, Sport Class Status, and IHF ID number if applicable;
- **Medical information about Athletes**, such as any (Underlying) Health Condition(s), Eligible Impairment(s), Diagnostic Information, medication(s), medical device(s) or implant(s) used, relevant medical procedure(s) undergone, and/or any Adaptive Equipment used;
- **Photography, audio and/or video recordings** taken during the Classification process;
- **Correspondence**, including when you contact us prior to, during, or following the Classification process (e.g., to raise questions, share information, or for other purposes relevant to Classification); and
- any **other Personal Information** you voluntarily provide to us or disclose to us upon request.

II. How we use Personal Information

We Process the Personal Information described above for a range of purposes, including as described in the table set out below:

To the extent applicable Data Protection Laws require a legal basis to Process Personal Information, we will rely on an appropriate lawful basis in consideration of the Personal Information Processed and relevant purpose(s), including:

- To comply with applicable laws, such as any applicable laws relevant to the integrity of Para sport or compulsory legal process(es);
- To perform a contract to which you are party, or to take steps at your request prior to entering into a contract;
- To fulfill our legitimate interests to operate and maintain the Classification process in order to ensure fair and meaningful Para sport competition, and/or the legitimate interests of third parties, such as other parties and bodies involved in the Classification process; and
- To serve the important public interests tied to the Classification process, such as protecting Athlete health and ensuring fair and meaningful Para sport competition.

To the extent consent is required to lawfully process your Personal Information, including under applicable Swiss data protection laws for the Processing of medical and health-related data submitted or provided under this Classification Registration Form (CRF), consent will be requested under this CRF form in accordance with applicable Data Protection Laws. If you consent to the Processing of your Personal Information, you may have the right under applicable Data Protection Laws to withdraw such consent at any time; however, this will not affect the lawfulness of our Processing of the relevant Personal Information prior to such withdrawal. Please note that, where such consent is necessary for the Classification process, withdrawing consent shall have certain consequences for Athletes, including preventing participation in, or continuation of, the Classification process and/or Para sport events.

III. Parties with whom we share Personal Information

We may need to share your Personal Information with the following parties as part of the Classification process in accordance with the IHF Classification Rules:

- **UHC Assessors, Classifiers and IHF personnel** involved in the Classification process;
- **The IPC and other International Federations (and their personnel)** for purposes related to Classification;
- **Service providers and contractors** we work with to manage and administer the Classification process;
- **Law enforcement and other governmental authorities** as necessary to comply with applicable law; and
- **Other third parties** at your direction or with your consent, or otherwise as disclosed to you in accordance with applicable Data Protection Laws.

Please also note that your name, gender, year of birth, nationality, Sport Class, Sport Class Status, any designations, any 're-evaluation' status attached to a designation, any tracking codes, and any current designation of Intentional Misrepresentation may be published by IHF on a Classification Master List in accordance with the IHF Classification Rules and the IPC regulations and standards.

IV. International transfers of Personal Information

You may participate in a Para sport event or Classification process outside of the jurisdiction where you reside, or we may need to share Personal Information with parties as described above who may be located in other jurisdictions. To the extent applicable Data Protection Laws impose restrictions on international transfers of Personal Information, we will implement measures to ensure compliance with such restrictions, such as by transferring on the basis of an adequacy decision, implementing standard contractual provisions with the recipient(s) of such Personal Information (which you may have the right to receive a copy of upon request), relying on an applicable derogation, or otherwise in accordance with applicable Data Protection Laws. You may contact us with any questions you have about any international transfers of your Personal Information.

V. Security of Personal Information

We have adopted measures, including administrative, technical, physical and contractual measures, to protect Personal Information against theft, damage, loss and unauthorised access, use, modification or disclosure.

VI. Retention of Personal Information

We will retain your Personal Information for as long as necessary to fulfil the purpose(s) for which it was collected, and thereafter as necessary to comply with applicable laws and in accordance with retention policies and standards applicable to us as an International Federation.

VII. Minors

Certain Para sport events and Competitions may permit the participation of Minors who are not yet of the age of majority under applicable law. Where we Process the Personal Information of Minors, we do so in accordance with applicable Data Protection Laws, including by obtaining consent from the parent or guardian of the Minor where required.

VIII. Personal Information rights

Under applicable Data Protection Laws and the International Standard for Classification Data Protection, and subject to applicable exceptions or exemptions, you may have certain rights in relation to your Personal Information, such as:

- The right to request access to your Personal Information;
- The right to request correction or deletion of your Personal Information;
- The right to restrict or object to the Processing of your Personal Information;
- The right to data portability (where applicable); and
- Any other rights recognised by applicable Data Protection Laws.

If you wish to submit a request in relation to your Personal Information, contact us where indicated below and we will handle your request in accordance with applicable Data Protection Laws. If you are not satisfied with how we have addressed your request, or have other concerns about our Processing of your Personal Information, you may have the right to lodge a complaint with a competent data protection authority.
